#### National Achievers Society - 2023-2024 - Application Requirements & Information

- 1. Must be a student enrolled in 4<sup>th</sup> through 9<sup>th</sup> grade at the time of application.
- 2. Must have a minimum 3.0 weighted GPA Must meet the academic requirement of having at least (2) A grades and the rest B grades for the last three (3) consecutive grading periods. One (1) "C" grade may replace the "B" grade only in honors, gifted, or advanced placement class only. No D's or F's are permitted. Have no grades below a B in conduct (if applicable).
- 3. Students must be recommended by two adults, such as parent, teacher, counselor, pastor, principal, or other person; one <u>must</u> be a school official. The <u>signed</u> letter of recommendation (or template provided below) must include the following information: Name of person nominating the student, name of candidate, description of the student's accomplishments, and the reason for the recommendation.
- 4. Application must include a Laws of Life Essay (instructions below)
- 5. Applicants who provide appropriate documentation of a completed community service project will be given priority in the application process.
- 6. A \*NON-REFUNDABLE FEE OF \$75.00\* to cover jacket and dues is required for the first year. The sponsor may be an individual, parent, club, organization, or entity willing to pay the fee and be supportive of the achiever. Payment will be expected once/if student is inducted. The fee is not required during the application process.
- 7. Must officially participate in an Induction Ceremony to become a full-fledged member of the Society.

### **APPLICATION DEADLINE: Friday, October 6, 2023**

#### **Fall 2023 - INDUCTION CEREMONY:**

Saturday, November 11, 2023, 10:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.

Virtual application must be completed by the application deadline. Non-refundable \$75.00 Sponsorship fee will be required prior to induction ceremony.

Decisions will be sent via email provided on application at least 2 weeks prior to induction ceremony.

**Laws of Life Essay**

2	4 <sup>th</sup> grade – 9 <sup>th</sup> -grade report card. <b>Pass three consecutive REPORT CARDS</b> (no D's or F's are permitted the last 3 consecutive report cards). Progress reports do not count as report cards. 3	Two Adult Recommendation Letters	Students must be recommended by two adults, such as parent, teacher, counselor, pastor, principal, or other person; one must be a school official. The recommendation must include the following information: Name of person nominating the student, name of candidate, description of the student's accomplishments, and the reason for the recommendation.	
5	Laws of Life Essay	Application must include a Laws of Life Essay (See 22-23 Virtual Application details)	
6	Sponsorship Fee	Must have a sponsor who pays a *NON-REFUNDABLE FEE OF \$75.00* to cover jacket and dues for the first year. The sponsor may be an individual, parent, club, organization, or entity willing to pay the fee and be supportive of the achiever. Eligible applicants are not included by being inducted in a subsequent ceremony only. No personal checks are accepted. Please make money orders, cashier's check, or business checks payable to UCF McKnight Center of Excellence. Please note the candidate's name on the payment. NO CASH PAYMENT ACCEPTED.	



#### 2023-2024 NAS Participant Expectations

All National Achievers Society Members are expected to adhere to the requirements listed below.

Failure to adhere to the established requirements will result in the Achiever becoming Inactive in the Society. Please initial.

1 Attend Monthly Meetings (minimum 3 to remain active. Offering 5).
2 Attend and Participate in at least (4) MCOE Activities such as College Readiness Workshops, Community Service, College Tour, Induction Ceremony, Cultural/Community Events. (Offering 5-6)
4Submit <b>Achiever dues</b> by end of September (\$25.00 per Achiever) (The \$75.00 sponsorship fee for new inductees covers this cost for the first year).
5Submit <b>Parent Alliance dues</b> by end of September (\$25.00 per Household) (New Inductees are expected to submit this within the first few months of Induction to the NAS Parent Alliance Treasurer).
6 Submit report cards every grading period.
7 Maintain a minimum 3.0 grade point average.
8Submit <b>Community Service Verification Form</b> by end of program year. (Individual or Group).
9Submit forms and requested information in a timely manner (FEF Application of Participation, Community Service Verification, Brain Bowl forms, Contact information updates, and Evaluations/Survey).
10Achievers are expected to uphold the code of conduct and the basic tenets of the society at all times.
